
Network Access Security Information





Mission

Dillard University Distance Education for Authentic Learning (DEAL) will engage, empower, and inspire global learners by re-imagining and redefining curriculum to enact positive change and meet the competitive demands of a 21st century society. DEAL courses and programs will support student success by employing on-demand, technology-integrated, real-world relevant teaching and learning not constrained to brick and mortar classrooms.

Dillard University's D.E.A.L. includes both hybrid and fully online courses.

DEAL is powered by <u>Canvas LMS</u> by Instructure

Hybrid: Hybrid classes at Dillard University combine traditional classroom instruction with a significant amount (33% - 75%) of instruction delivered through instructional technology

Online: Online classes at Dillard University have the bulk of the material delivered online via Canvas LMS. Face-to-face sessions are discouraged but acceptable up to 5% of instructional time (maximum of two 1 hour meetings during a long semester). Proctored exams are allowed.

Students must show their competence and familiarity with our **Canvas LMS** to enroll in a hybrid or online course section. To show this competence, students must hold a course completion certificate from Canvas LMS 101: Canvas Onboarding and Student Readiness for eLearning Course prior to enrolling in the course section.

Unicheck is an online plagiarism and content checker that detects same or similar content of documents and webpages.

Unicheck is an app used within Canvas.

- scans papers against the internet, open sources, and student paper databases.
- has unlimited file storage to store assignments and reports.
- doesn't need the installation of additional programs.





- includes spell check, grammar check, editing tools, and tips for proper citation.
- has all text matches, citations and references highlighted
- can also track how originality and similarity rates change over time as data is collected.
- can be added to Canvas as an external app feature. They can be added to an individual course or all courses in an account. Once configured they can be linked through modules and create assignments for assessment tools.
