TRANSFER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Dillard University offers scholarships and grants to qualifying applicants, who meet the minimum requirements for admission, to help assist in completing their bachelor's degree at Dillard University. Once the prospective student has completed the admission application process, meaning they have submitted all required transcripts and documents, their application will be reviewed for eligibility to receive one of our transfer scholarships or grants.
